Language Insights from our March 2021 Survey

- We asked organizations about the languages spoken by their immigrant families. Here are the top results:
 - 93% Spanish, 42% Arabic, 34% French, 25% Chinese, 22% Vietnamese
 - 60% indicated they served other languages in an open-ended option
 - One organization indicated they serve these families speaking:
 Albanian, Armenian, English-Based Creole, German, Haitian Creole,
 Hebrew, Italian, Japanese, Nepali, Newari, Pashto, Persian, Punjabi,
 Russian, Sherpa, Sindhi, Somali, Spanish, Tibetan, Turkish, Urdu, and
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Language Insights from our March 2021 Survey

- We asked organizations about the languages they or their collaborative provide services in. Here are the top results:
 - 86% Spanish, 23% Arabic, 20% French, 16% Chinese, 14% Vietnamese
 - 44% indicated they provide service in other languages in an openended option
 - Many indicated a commitment to providing service in any language using outside interpreters and collaborations.




The Two-Generation (2Gen) Approach
